(John 11:23-27)**

1. Your first problem is you think you know it all. (23-24)

- Next to God’s knowledge, our best is elementary.
- ⇒ Lord, help me grasp the limits of my knowledge.

2. Your second problem is you don’t know who I am! (25)

- “I Am” = “I Am that I Am” of Exodus 3:14.
- Jesus is the great “I Am” = Jesus is God.
- ⇒ Lord, help me grasp that you are God! (25)

3. Your third problem is you haven’t figured out what life is all about yet. (25)

- Life in Eden wasn’t about the garden;
it was about walking with God!
- ⇒ Lord, help me learn that real life is found in You!

4. Your fourth problem is you haven’t decided what to believe in yet.

- “Do you believe this?” = Eternity’s most important question.
- Believe ≠ to accept the truth of a statement
(The demons believe! James 2:19)
- Believe = to live out the truth of a statement
(James 2:20-26).
- ⇒ The key: stop looking at our problem,
and look at a Person: Jesus!
