Review: Faith is taking one’s stand on real evidence that God exists and in Christ our future will be vastly better!

1a. If God doesn’t exist, it’s logical to be afraid of kings and other people in power. (23, 27)

1b. But if God exists, there is a power far greater than any earthly power!

- Psm 118:6; Isaiah 9:6

→ If God exists, being unafraid of humans is a brilliant choice!

2a. If God doesn’t exist, it’s illogical to choose to be Mistreated by others in this life. (24-26)

2b. But if God exists, there are mistreatments and rewards far greater than all earthly treatments!

- Psm 19:11; Prov 19:17; Mt 5:12; 2 Cor 4:17; Rev 22:12

→ If God exists, choosing mistreatment for being a Christian is a brilliant choice!

3a. If God doesn’t exist, it’s illogical to believe in supernatural beings that we can’t see (27-29).

3b. But if God exists, there must also exist a supernatural world and supernatural beings far more powerful than humans!

- Eph 6:10-13; 2 Cor 4:16-18

→ If God exists, choosing to believe in Him even though we can’t see him is a brilliant choice!
