Review: Our mission in life as Christians:

To let God love us and love others through us!

Point: God's primary will is to love us personally & daily.

Problem: We don't let God! We obstruct, forget, or miss it.

Solution: Let God love us! Expect it, watch for it, & thank Him.

1. God loves us—mistakes and all. (15-26)

- "I have no husband" "You are right...you've had five."
 - She made moral mistakes.
- "Sir, I see you are a prophet. Our fathers..."
 - She made theological mistakes.

Personally: Does God love me in spite of my mistakes?

2. God wants His love to flow through us to others. (27-42)

- "Leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town
And said to the people..."
 - Her priorities suddenly changed.
- "Could this man be the Christ? He told me"
 - She shared her personal experience, her testimony.
- "Many of the Samaritans believed in him because of her..."
 - She had an eternal impact in the lives of many!

The Secret to the Dynamic Christian Life:

The Christian life is like a River!

In order to remain healthy, it has to flow.

But if we damn it up, it gets unhealthy and stagnant.

3. God wants us to "Open our Eyes" and let His love flow through us to others, one person at a time. (35)

Personally: Lord, who do you want to love through me today?
