**1. What we see is not all there is. (1-9)**

- See Matthew 1:18-21; Luke 1:26-28; Ephesians 6:10-13  
⇒ I live in a world inhabited by angel beings.

**2. What we don't see are holy angels. (10-14)**

- “Angel” (*malek* and *angelos*) = messenger.
  - In the Bible, angels are also called:
    - Daniel 10:13                - princes
    - Daniel 4:13; 17           - holy ones
    - Psalm 8:5                 - heavenly beings
    - Luke 2:13                 - heavenly host
    - 2 Corinthians 11:4     - angel(s) of light
- ⇒ I have real helpers in this world -- angels!

**3. What we don't see are fallen angels. (13, 20)**

- “demon” = *daimon* = divider (From the root “to divide”)
  - In the Bible, demons are also called:
    - Daniel 10:13               - princes
    - Matthew 8:31             - devils
    - Luke 4:33                 - evil spirits
    - Ephesians 6:12          - rulers, authorities, powers of this  
    dark world, spiritual forces of evil
- ⇒ I have real enemies in this world -- demons!

**4. What can believers do?**

- a. Accept the truth that a supernatural world exists.
- b. Learn to discern between spirits.
- c. Learn to defeat the darkness by turning on the light.
